EFFICIENT WEALTH STRUCTURING OPPORTUNITIES

The Singapore VCC is a fund structure regulated by the Monetary Authority of Singapore ("MAS") designed to support a wide range of strategies, from Private Equity and Venture Capital to fund of funds and family wealth structuring.

Unlike a traditional company structure, a VCC fund:

- Is a collective investment scheme, including masterfeeder models
- Requires a MAS-licensed fund manager
- Offers enhanced shareholder and financial confidentiality
- Allows open-ended or closed-ended flexibility
- Can be set up as a standalone fund or as an umbrella with ringfenced sub-funds

Whether used by asset owners, fund managers, or wealth platforms, the VCC fund allows you to grow strategically while remaining compliant, tax-efficient, and investor-aligned.

SOLUTIONS IN ACTION

1. PRIVATE MARKET ASSET OWNER (SEED STRATEGY)

A technology entrepreneur seeded a VCC fund with both private and listed assets. By acting as the first investor, they attracted like-minded co-investors, retained technical influence via a board seat, and began a phased exit, all while a licensed fund manager handled investment decisions and compliance.


This structure enables a strategic asset owner to contribute private and public investments in specie, while new investors enter via cash subscriptions. The fund manager provides oversight, with liquidity terms and drawdowns customized per sub-fund.

2. PE/VC FUND STRUCTURING

An investment team transitioned from a single-family office to a commercial multi-family platform. Two sub-funds were launched: one for private assets and another for public market exposure, offering flexibility for new investors while retaining control.

The sub-advisor recommends investments, which the fund manager evaluates and executes under the terms of the Investment Management Agreement.



USING A VCC UMBRELLA STRUCTURE TO INVEST INTO MULTIPLE PE STRATEGIES

As the illustration shows, a VCC can house multiple sub-funds under one umbrella, each aligned to different PE strategies. Investors subscribe into targeted sub-funds while the fund manager, and any sub-advisors, guide asset selection and compliance under the Investment Management Agreement.

3. WEALTH MANAGER FUND OVERLAY

A licensed advisory firm used a VCC to launch a branded overlay fund, investing in a range of underlying third-party funds. Multiple sub-funds enabled differentiated client offerings under one regulatory umbrella.

4. FUND OF FUNDS & FEEDER VEHICLES

A fund sponsor used a VCC to pool investor capital and access highbarrier private strategies. In parallel, a feeder structure targeted Asian LPs using Singapore's network of DTAs to optimize returns and reduce withholding taxes.

5. FOREIGN FUND MANAGERS ENTERING ASIA

A Europe-based fund manager launched a Singapore VCC fund to raise assets from HNWIs and institutional investors across

Asia, leveraging the jurisdiction's AAA rating and fund-friendly environment.
